WILL YOUR CHILD BE ABSENT FOR THE DAY? Please always remember to call us to let us know, as we do need to account for every student, every day. Thank you!

WINTER GEAR REQUEST: As the cool weather has finally come our way, we have some requests for you to consider as you begin to gather your child's cold weather gear. The process of preparing children to go outside every day (sometimes twice), can be a long and tricky one to handle for 2 teachers. There are some things you can do at home to make this go smoother for us.

- **Please be sure to LABEL ALL ITEMS (even boots).** This is tremendously helpful, especially as children will soon be bringing in multiple items...jackets, hats, mittens, snow pants, boots, etc. Then they leave them in the hallway, and when we go outside for recess, they sometimes don't recall what they brought in that day.
- Also, we ask that you send your child to school wearing mittens, not gloves, unless he/she is able to put the gloves on independently. This really helps us to get outside for recess in a timely manner.
- Please take some time over the next week or two to help your child practice putting on his/her own coat/mittens/boots, etc. We are teaching (and helping as well) at school, but practice at home is so helpful. You would be surprised at how well kids can do with practice!

SNOW CANCELLATION POLICY: While we are extremely confident that it will not snow this year, here is a copy of the snow policy - just in case! ©

Southborough Village Preschool's main objective during bad weather is to ensure the safety of our staff and children. If the Southborough Public Schools are closed due to inclement weather, Southborough Village Preschool will always be closed as well. While we will make an effort to email you in the case of a closing, there is always the chance that due to power outages, this will not be possible. We strongly recommend that you rely on the news/radio/websites to hear of a school closing in Southborough. If Southborough Public Schools are closed, Southborough Village Preschool will be as well.

If there is a delay to the start of the public school opening, we will most likely open Southborough Village Preschool with a delay as well, at the discretion of the Directors. If there is a 2-hour delay, all morning classes at the Preschool will be cancelled, but PM classes will most likely be held, and Early Drop-off will begin at 11:00 AM. In the case of a delay, full-day students will still eat lunch at school. We also reserve the right of judgment to close the Preschool early due to poor weather conditions. In this case, parents and caregivers will be notified.
