A Few Small Notes...

Tuition Due: The final payment for families on the five payment plan, is due at this time. Please see Laura Eppen if you have any questions regarding your final tuition payment. Thank you!

Medical Physicals: Has your child had a physical in the last few months, or since September? If so, please bring us a copy of the updated physical report as soon as possible. We are required by the Department of Early Education and Care to have current physicals (within one year), on file for each student. We thank you for your assistance with this important part of our children's records.

Food Pantry: As you know, we are collecting items for the local Food Pantry. For the months of April and May, they are in need of **toilet paper and children's snacks.** Thank you!

Parking: Please pull all the way up the fence if you are dropping off or picking up in our parking lot. This allows a second car to pull in behind you, so as to maximize the use of the parking lot for families. We recognize that you might be concerned about being blocked in by a car if you pull up, so we do ask that if people are planning to stay for longer than just a few moments, please park on the street. If you are parked behind someone in the parking lot, please take care to return to your car quickly. This method really does enable more families to use our parking lot, quickly and safely.

Art Appreciation at SVP: We are continuing to enjoy our Art Appreciation unit and look forward to one more week of artist and technique exploration.
