

**21-22 TRAVEL GUIDELINES:**

(Updated 8/24/21)

The Public Schools of Northborough and Southborough require the following guidelines be met when returning to school after travel outside of Massachusetts.

<b>DOMESTIC TRAVEL</b>	<b>THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA MUST BE MET TO RETURN TO SCHOOL</b>
Travel by plane, train or bus (or other shared public transportation)	<p><b>Notify the school nurse of travel</b></p> <p>Unvaccinated individuals</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● PCR test on or after Day 5 after return (Day 0 is date of arrival in MA)</li><li>● Mask at school except while eating until negative PCR</li><li>● Monitor for symptoms</li><li>● No quarantine (unless symptomatic)</li></ul> <p>Vaccinated individuals</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Monitor for symptoms</li><li>● No quarantine (unless symptomatic)</li></ul>
<b>INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL</b>	<b>THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA MUST BE MET TO RETURN TO SCHOOL</b>
Travel by plane, train or bus (or other shared public transportation)	<p><b>Notify the school nurse of travel</b></p> <p>Unvaccinated individuals</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● PCR test on or after Day 5 after return (Day 0 is date of arrival in US)</li><li>● Mask at school except while eating until negative PCR</li><li>● Monitor for symptoms</li><li>● No quarantine (unless symptomatic)</li></ul> <p>Vaccinated individuals</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● PCR test 3-5 days after return (Day 0 is date of arrival in US)</li><li>● Monitor for symptoms</li><li>● No quarantine (unless symptomatic)</li></ul>
