Kindergarten is right around the corner! Many of our students will be going to kindergarten in the fall. The Finn School in Southborough has sent us the forms they would like us to fill out for each child that we will be sending on to kindergarten. We will need a signature from you in order for us to complete the forms and release them to the Finn School, so please be sure to sign your child's form before the end of next week (we'll have them available at drop-off and pick-up). If your child's future elementary school is in a town other than Southborough, and they have given you a form for us to fill out, please sign it and bring it to us as soon as possible. Thank you!

Physicals: Please remember to send us updated physicals if your child has his/her annual appointment this spring. We are required to always have the most up to date physicals (within one year) and medical paperwork (IHCP's) in our student files.

End of the Year Family Celebrations: We are excited to be able to invite you to our end of the year Family Celebrations this year! Each class will be hosting a Family Celebration on their last day of school. The MWF classes will be inviting you to a celebration on Monday, June 6th and the T/Th classes will be inviting you to a celebration on Tuesday, June 7th. Each celebration will be last approximately 45 minutes and will be held primarily outdoors. Please note that this event is for parents only, so we do ask that you make arrangements for siblings. See the invitation below for more details regarding your child's Family Celebration. We look forward to seeing you!

Summer Fun Program: This year, we are excited to be returning to another fun SVP tradition, Summer Fun Days! This is a completely optional program that you are welcome to sign your child up for. During these few days, we celebrate the arrival of summer with fun activities and outdoor play.

- **Summer Fun days will be Wednesday, 6/8, Thursday, 6/9 and Friday, 6/10, from 9:00 AM-1:00 PM (send your child with a nut-free lunch).**
- The fee for the Summer Fun Program is \$50.00 per day. Siblings will receive a 50% discount for the second child.
- We are limited to 39 students per day and students will have the opportunity to move between the classrooms as they feel comfortable.
- Registration for Summer Fun Days will begin on Monday, May 23rd. Sign-up sheets will be available at the front door, or feel free to give us a call/email and we can sign your child up.
- We ask that initially you only sign your child up for days that he/she normally attends school, but the following week on Tuesday, May 31st, you can register your child for any additional available Summer Fun dates.
- Stay tuned...we will be sending out more information in the coming weeks.

Scholastic Book Club: On occasion, we offer an opportunity to order books through Scholastic Book Clubs. Please note that ordering is completely optional, but if you are interested, feel free to look at the catalog that was sent home this week, as well as many others available online. If you choose to order books, you can order easily online. All books will be shipped to our school and we will distribute them to you upon their arrival. We anticipate delivery within a few weeks. Please note: The deadline for ordering from these catalogs is **Tuesday, May 10th**.
