We thank you for your help as we work to keep our students safe.

**End of the Year Family Celebrations:** We are excited to be able to invite you to our end-of-the year Family Celebrations this year. Each class will be hosting a Family Celebration on their last day of school. The MWF classes will be inviting you to a celebration on Monday, June 5<sup>th</sup> and the T/Th classes will be inviting you to a celebration on Tuesday, June 6<sup>th</sup>. Each celebration will last approximately 30-45 minutes and will be held primarily outdoors. In order to make the Family Celebration a special event for your child, please consider making alternative arrangement for siblings. **Scholastic Book Club:** On occasion, we offer an opportunity to order books through Scholastic Book Clubs. Please note that ordering is completely optional, but if you are interested, feel free to look at the book catalogs that will be sent home on Monday/Tuesday of this week, as well as many other catalogs that are available online. If you choose to order books, you can order easily online. All books will be shipped to our school and we will distribute them to you upon their arrival. We anticipate delivery within a few weeks.

While shopping online, just type in scholastic.com/readingclub and enter the Class Activation Code: K3CFL. The deadline for ordering from these catalogs is Friday, May 5<sup>th</sup>.

**SVP Book Nook:** We've really been enjoying watching the kids browse at the Book Nook before and after school! As a reminder, all of the books are there for the taking, so please stop by and take as many as you or your little ones would like. Feel free to donate books that you are done with as well. We're so happy to see our families enjoying this fun community opportunity. Please spread the word to friends and family who might also be interested.

**Summer Fun Program:** This year, we are excited to be able to offer another fun SVP tradition, Summer Fun Days! This is a completely optional program that you are welcome to sign your child up for. During these few days, we celebrate the arrival of summer with fun activities and outdoor play.

- Summer Fun days will be Wednesday, 6/7, Thursday, 6/8 and Friday, 6/9, from 9:00 AM-1:00 PM.
- Please send your child with a nut-free lunch.
- The fee for the Summer Fun Program is \$50.00 per day. Siblings will receive a 50% discount for the second child.
- Students will have the opportunity to move between the classrooms as they feel comfortable.
- Registration for Summer Fun Days will begin on **Monday**, **May 15**<sup>th</sup>. Sign-up sheets will be available at the front door, or feel free to give us a call/email and we can sign your child up for you.
- We ask that initially you only sign your child up for days that he/she normally attends school, but the following week on Monday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>, you can register your child for any additional available Summer Fun dates.

- Family Celebrations will be held on the last regular days of school, on <u>Monday</u>, <u>June 5<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday</u>, <u>June 6<sup>th</sup></u>.
- <u>Please be sure to RSVP to your child's teacher</u>. It is very important that each child have a parent or parents attend their Family Celebration. In the case that neither parent can attend, we ask that you send another special person to attend in your place (grandparent, aunt or uncle, etc.). Please be sure to let your child's teacher know if you will be attending the Family Celebration or if someone else will.
- <u>Please arrive on time.</u> We stagger the Family Celebration times so that there is only one Celebration going on at the school at a time. Because of this, we ask that you be prompt. We will need to be sure to start right on time, in order to keep to our tight schedule. Thank you!
- In order to make the Family Celebration a special event for your child, please consider making alternative arrangements for young siblings.
