We look forward to beginning a new school year with your family and hope that you are excited as well. Hopefully this email will answer any questions that you might have, but don't hesitate to reach out if you have any further questions or concerns. We are always here to help!

As we head into the summer months, we would like to touch base with you briefly regarding a few important school notes. You can expect an Enrollment Packet, including a more detailed letter, information regarding your child's teachers, student file paperwork, tuition payment plans, and back-to-school tips from us by the middle of August. In that packet you will find information regarding everything you will need to know for September. In the meantime, we hope that you find this letter, and the attached 2023-2024 school calendar, to be helpful as you enjoy your summer and look forward to fall.

If you are new to SVP, we welcome you! Please reply to this email as soon as possible so that we know you received it, and be sure to let us know if you would like us to add or remove any email addresses from our contact list. Please don't hesitate to reach out to us over the summer if you have any questions at all. DATES AND SCHEDULES TO NOTE: At SVP, we enjoy beginning our school year with Individual Parent/Child/Teacher Conferences on Thursday, September 7<sup>th</sup> and Friday, September 8<sup>th</sup>, followed by our first regular week of classes beginning on Monday, September 11<sup>th</sup>.

Our individual Parent/Child/Teacher Conferences will be held every 15-20 minutes, throughout the day on September 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>. Our T/TH students will be invited to come in for their conferences on Thursday, September 7<sup>th</sup>, and our M/W/F students will be invited in on Friday, September 8th. In general, you can expect that AM students will have conferences in the morning, PM students will have conferences in the afternoon, and Full Day students will be scheduled throughout the day. We do have some flexibility though, so when the time comes to schedule your child's conference, don't hesitate to reach out with your scheduling needs. Your child's teacher will be contacting you regarding your conference date and time in mid-August. This conference will be an opportunity for your child to meet his or her new teachers, and for you to ask questions and share any information you would like us to know about your child. On the day of your conference you will also have an opportunity to select your payment plan for tuition and make your first tuition payment of the school year. Detailed tuition payment plan information will be provided in the August mailing.

Please note: In an attempt to alleviate congestion in our parking lot, we stagger our class start/stop times. Each day, two of our classes begin at 8:45 AM and two of them begin at 9:00 AM. If you have more than one child/student, and they have different start times, please feel free to being both at the earlier start time, and we will happily have your child join us in the Early Drop-Off room for no additional fee.

Also, if it is helpful for you, we invite you to schedule your arrival at SVP anytime within our drop-off and pick-up windows. We find this can also help to alleviate congestion in our parking lot and it may help if you are also managing transportation for siblings at other schools, etc.

- o If your child's class begins at 8:45 AM, you may drop off anytime between 8:45 and 9:00 AM.
- o If your child's class begins at 9:00 AM, you may drop off anytime between 9:00 and 9:15 AM.
- o If your child's class ends at 2:45 PM, you may pick up anytime between 2:30 and 2:45 PM.
- o If your child's class ends at 3:00 PM, you may pick up anytime between 2:45 and 3:00 PM.

## Monday/Wednesday/Friday Class Schedule:

- The Toddler Class will run from 8:45-11:30 AM
- The Three Half-Day AM Class will run from 8:45-11:45 AM
- The Three Half-Day PM Class will run from 11:45-2:45 PM
- The Three Full-Day Pre-K Classes will run from 9:00-3:00 PM

## **Tuesday/Thursday Class Schedule:**

- The Toddler Class will run from 8:45-11:30 AM
- The Two Half-Day AM Class will run from 8:45-11:45 AM (Note: This is an updated start time.)
- The Two Half-Day PM Class will run from 11:45-2:45 PM (Note: this is an updated start time.)
- The Two Full-Day Classes will run from 9:00-3:00 PM

You will receive your child's class and teacher assignment in our August packet mailing.

**Early Drop-Off and Playschool:** Please remember that, once school starts, we offer Early Drop-Off every day beginning at 8:00 AM. Playschool will be offered every day from 3:00-3:30 PM. You will receive updated information regarding these fun extension options in the August mailing.

PAPERWORK NOTE: By mid-August you will be receiving an Enrollment Packet from us, including a newsletter and required paperwork, that you must return to us at your September Parent/Child/Teacher Conference. This packet will include an Enrollment Form (contact info), annual Developmental History, Authorizations, First Aid Consent Form, a Student Survey and tuition payment plans. State licensing regulations mandate that you must have this packet filled out and returned to us by the time of your conference so that your child can begin school the following week. At that time, you must also bring us a current physical and immunization record.

Students will not be able to begin school without this paperwork (and a physical) on file. No exceptions can be made. We take our commitment (and State requirement) very seriously to have the most current information available for each student in our care. Thank you for your support with this important policy.

PHYSICALS: In order to begin school, all children are required to have a current physical and immunization records (within one year) on file at the Preschool. If your child's latest physical is dated September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022 or earlier, it will be expired by our first day of school. Please keep this in mind as you go through the summer, and plan accordingly so that your child can begin school on the first day. We ask that you bring a copy of your child's current physical and immunization record to your September conference.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If your child has a prescribed inhaler, EPI Pen or daily medication, we will need to have those medications, labeled (with a pharmacy label), for storage in the classroom, in order for your child to begin school, even if you don't anticipate that we will ever need to use them. You will also need to have your child's physician fill out an Individualized Health Care Plan and Medication Consent Form for your child's file. If you know that you will need these forms for your child, please respond to this email so that we can send the paperwork to you now, as it can take several weeks for necessary appointments and forms to be filled out.

Southborough Village Preschool is an entirely NUT-FREE school. We require all foods that are brought into the school to be nut-free. While we provide daily nut-free snacks, if your child will be staying for lunch in the fall, we suggest taking time this summer to experiment with some nut-free lunch options to pack in his/her lunchbox. If your child has any other dietary needs or restrictions, do let us know so we can make necessary accommodations.

Finally, we ask that all students bring a water bottle every day, along with an ample sized backpack and a lunch box (for those eating lunch at school-PM and Full Day classes). Be sure to label all of these items.

**SVP Book Nook:** We truly enjoyed our new SVP Book Nook this year and plan to continue this fun activity in September. The Book Nook can be found in front of the school, to the right side of the front door. During the

school year, we invited families to leave books in the Book Nook that they were finished with, and the kids had a wonderful time selecting new books to take home. The kids are welcome to keep any books that they like, or they can return them at any point in the school year, and take home new ones. If you find yourself cleaning our your bookshelves this summer, and find some children's books (any level) that you are ready to pass along, please save them for us, or feel free to leave them in our Book Nook at any point in the next few months. We will gather them over the course of the summer and fill the Book Nook for our first week of school!

We sincerely thank you for choosing Southborough Village Preschool for your child and truly appreciate that you have given us the opportunity to be such an important part of your child's lifelong journey of learning. We hope that you have a wonderful summer vacation and that you enjoy this time with your family. We will mail out our Enrollment Packets in early August and our teachers will be reaching out to you shortly after that, to set up your child's Parent/Child/Teacher Conference. In the meantime, don't hesitate to contact us if you have any questions or concerns about next year, we are always happy to help. We look forward to an exciting year with you all.
