Each celebration will last approximately 45 minutes and will be held primarily outdoors. We do need at least one guest for each child's Family Celebration. Summer Fun Program: We are excited to be planning our upcoming Summer Fun Days! This is a completely optional program that you are welcome to sign your child up for. During these few days, we celebrate the arrival of summer with fun activities and outdoor play.

- Summer Fun days will be Wednesday, 6/4, Thursday, 6/5 and Friday, 6/6, from 9:00 AM-1:00 PM (send your child with a nut-free lunch).
- The fee for the Summer Fun Program is \$50.00 per day. Siblings will receive a 50% discount.
- Students will have the opportunity to move between the classrooms as they feel comfortable.
- Registration for Summer Fun Days will begin on Monday, May 12th. Sign-up sheets will be available at the front door, or feel free to give us a call/email and we can sign your child up.
- We ask that initially you only sign your child up for days that he/she normally attends school, but the following week on Tuesday, May 19th, you can register your child for any additional available dates.

Openings at SVP: We have a few openings remaining for the 2025-2026 school year, if you or anyone one you know is interested. Family Celebrations at SVP!

The annual end of the year Family Celebrations are a lot of fun at Southborough Village Preschool! The children have been working on some special songs for you and we know you will love to see how much they have learned and grown this year. During your child's Family Celebration, your children will also be serving you a special snack as well as cool refreshments, for your enjoyment. This is also the day that you will receive your child's special year-end portfolio or journal. Below, you will find a few important things for you to know about your Family Celebrations as well as the class schedule. Be sure to let us know if you have any questions regarding the Celebrations.

- Family Celebrations will be held on the last regular days of school, on <u>Monday, June 2nd and Tuesday, June 3rd.</u>
- Please be sure to RSVP to your child's teacher, before the Celebration. It is very important that each child have a parent or parents attend their Family Celebration. In the case that neither parent can attend, we ask that you send another special person to attend in your place (grandparent, aunt or uncle, etc.). Please be sure to let your child's teacher know if you will be attending the Family Celebration or if someone else will.
- <u>Please arrive on time.</u> We stagger the Family Celebration times so that there is only one Celebration going on at the school at a time. Because of this, we ask that you be prompt. We will need to be sure to start right on time, in order to keep to our tight schedule. Thank you!
- In order to make the Family Celebration a special event for your child, please consider making alternative arrangements for young siblings, (unless you have a newborn, of course!).
